

Detroit Area Carpenters Wage Rates (for road building construction)

Effective the first full payroll period commencing on or after June 1, 2009

The 2009 wage rates and fringe benefit contributions for the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Michigan Regional Council of Carpenters that covers Wayne, Oakland, Macomb, Sanilac, St. Clair, Monroe and part of Livingston County (the Townships of Deerfield, Tyrone, Oceola, Hartland, Genoa and Brighton) are listed below and are effective the first full payroll period on or after June 1, 2009.
