

**June 1, 2014**

**To: All Michigan Infrastructure and Transportation Contractors**

The 2013 – 2021 labor contract with the Michigan Regional Council of Carpenters provides for a June 1, 2014 Gross Wage increase for Southeast Michigan of \$1.40/hr effective June 1, 2014. The increase has been allocated as follows: Base Wage \$0.50, Special Assesment Fund \$0.02, Health & Welfare Insurance \$0.25, Pension \$0.12, Annuity Fund \$0.38, Apprenticeship \$0.11 and Labor/Management Productivity & Training \$0.02.

Note: The increase is effective with your company’s first full payroll period that begins on or after June 1, 2014.

**Effective the first full payroll period commencing on or after June 1, 2014 through May 31, 2015.**

The 2014 wage and fringe benefit contributions for the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Michigan Regional Council of Carpenters that covers Wayne, Oakland, Macomb, Sanilac, St. Clair, Monroe and part of Livingston County (the Townships of Deerfield, Tyrone, Oceola, Hartland, Genoa and Brighton) are listed below and are effective the first full payroll period on or after June 1, 2014.
