Owner-Operator

Davis-Bacon – Not covered, submits certified payrolls noting owner-operator

Michigan Prevailing Wage - Not Covered

Product and material delivery truck drivers (ex. sand, asphalt, concrete)

- employed by contractor or subcontractor

Davis-Bacon – Subject to "site of work" and "di minimis" criteria

Michigan Prevailing Wage - Covered

- Product and material delivery truck drivers (ex. sand, asphalt, concrete)
 - not employed by contractor or subcontractor
 - no subcontract
 - PO or invoice

Davis-Bacon – Not covered, subject to "site of work" and "di minimis" criteria

Michigan Prevailing Wage - Not covered

- Product and material delivery truck drivers (ex. traffic control materials)
 - subcontract in place
 - simply drops product/material on site of work

Davis-Bacon – Not covered, drop off/pick up/maintaining subject to "di minimis" criteria

Michigan Prevailing Wage – Covered (subcontractor)

- **Broker trucking** product and material delivery (ex. sand, asphalt, concrete)
 - not employed by contractor or subcontractor
 - no subcontract
 - PO or invoice
 - priced per load
