**TO: ALL MICHIGAN INFRASTRUCTURE AND TRANSPORTATION CONTRACTORS  
(EXCLUDING SOUTHEASTERN MI)**

The 2021-2026 labor contract with the Michigan Regional Council of Carpenters provides for a June 1, 2023 Gross Wage increase for Southeast Michigan of \$1.75/hr. effective June 1, 2023. The increase has been allocated as follows: Base Wage \$1.29, U.B.C. Per Cap \$0.01, U.B.C. Training \$0.01, Apprenticeship \$0.20 and Annuity \$0.24.

Dues Deduction - Per the Michigan Regional Council By-Laws, dues shall be deducted from the employee's Base Wage. The amount of the dues is included in the Base Wage as stated above (currently 4.00%) and deducted on all premium and overtime pay.

Special Assessment of \$0.40 includes \$0.20 for the Building Fund.
