ROAD AGREEMENT

POWER OF ATTORNEY

The undersigned Firm hereby authorizes and appoints the Michigan Infrastructure & Transportation Association ("MITA") Labor Relations Division ("LRD"), as its agent to negotiate and sign collective bargaining agreements with the unions of the trades listed on the attached page (Attachment B).

The Firm will designate the trades to which it agrees to be bound by placing an "X" in the box immediately preceding the trade. This extension of authority extends only to trades so designated. When a trade is designated, the Firm agrees, and shall be bound, by all collective bargaining agreements negotiated by the MITA-LRD with that trade.

The MITA-LRD shall have authority to negotiate and execute all collective bargaining agreements in the State of Michigan for highway, bridge and airport construction work.

Authority is also hereby granted to handle and assist in all other matters incident to such agreements such as controversies as to the meaning and interpretation thereof, grievances or disputes arising under or in connection therewith, and the renewal or modification thereof.

It is understood that the MITA-LRD shall be acting only as agents, and in no event shall this delegation of authority be construed to bind the MITA-LRD or its individual members as principals or to hold them or any of them liable in any manner for any breach of any contract by the undersigned.

This Power of Attorney shall supersede and revoke any power of attorney or authorization dealing with the same matter that may heretofore have been given by the undersigned to any other person or association prior to this date.

This Power of Attorney shall continue until revoked in writing by the undersigned
