## Small Business Program (SBP) Goal-Setting Pilot

Effective with the November 7, 2025, bid letting, MDOT will be piloting an expanded Small Business Program (SBP) that applies an SBP goal on a select number of items within the bid letting. The selected bid letting items with an SBP goal will be identified by the "Required SBP Participation Goal" showing a percentage greater than 0% listed on the Advertisement.

The two lowest bidders must submit *MDOT Form 2668-Contractor Good Faith Efforts*, which summarizes the contractor's efforts, and an *MDOT Form 2668D Commitment Confirmation for SBE Subcontractors* for each SBE subcontractor listed on Form 2668. Forms 2668 and 2668D can be found at <a href="MDOT-WebForms">MDOT-WebForms</a> and are to be submitted to the <a href="MDOT-SBESheets@michigan.gov">MDOT-SBESheets@michigan.gov</a> mailbox within seven (7) calendar days of the bid letting.

Beginning with the January 2026 Bid Lettings, all bidders on projects with an SBP goal will be required to provide their proposed goal at time of bid.

Bidders are to utilize the <u>MDOT MUCP Public Application</u> page to identify SBEs and their associated work codes. All DBE firms are eligible to participate on MDOT contracts as an SBE.
